FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you very much for your entry, your start number is as per enclosed entry list.

Your start time at MC1 will be 10.30am plus your car number in minutes.

START PROCEDURE

Unload cars and proceed to trailer park (see map – what3word = ///straddled.scrolled.crunches) please park trailers tidily and with respect to other competitors. Trailers are left at the venue at owner's own risk. Car parking has been paid for by the club for the day.

Report to noise which is at Teme Valley Tractors opening at 07:30 and closes at 09:15 (see map itself.angle.crouching).

Collect process card; Please write your car number on this process card.

Upon passing noise test report to Scrutineering at Knighton Tyres depot (fells.disprove.snapped) and opens at 07:30 and closes at 09:30 (see map) please follow Marshals instructions.

After successful completion of scrutineering Marshalls will direct you to car parking.

MC0 is at Knighton Football Club. Follow arrows from carpark.

PLEASE NOTE YOUR MARSHAL MUST BE SIGNED ON BY 9.30am. Your marshal should sign on with the Chief Marshal before you attend competitor's signing on. Remember No Marshal – No Start ASR15.

Please ensure your Marshall has the 'What3Words' app on their phone. All Marshalls must bring and wear high-viz on the tests.

Please ensure that you have provided all required documents and completed your entry form ONLINE – this needs to be done BEFORE the day of the event.

Report to signing on with your process card where competitors will be issued with a rally pack containing rally plates, timecards, etc.

ASR 3.

D.O.E authorisation will be available at signing on for inspection.

ASR 7

Noise and Scrutineering opens at 07:30am not 07:45am

Please ensure that both crews attend the Drivers briefing at Football Club at 10:00am prompt not 10:15am

Car 0 will collect a road book from MC 1 at 10:30 am, there will be no MCO

ASR 9

Judges of Fact: All named officials and signed on Marshals.

Driving Standards Observers: A list Driving Standards Observers will be available for inspection on the official notice board.

ASR 14

Total mileage will be approx 95 miles; 31 test miles and 64 road miles. Fuel is available at Llanbadarn Fynydd Petrol Station which will be passed a number of times during the day – Super Unleaded fuel is available at this venue. Time is built into road sections for you to re-fuel.

The route information will be given out in MC1

ASR 21

Penalties

Failing to stop astride a line correctly at Pre-Finish and Finish control	1 minute
Failure to record a Route Check (RC) in Ink	1 Fail per RC
Not recording the information on a code board or no validation signature obtained at the next manned control	10 minutes / 1 Fail

ASR 22

TEST FINISH CONTROL (TF)

Test Finish Controls will be marked by a (C) board. For the safety of the marshal there are two Stop Astride Lines before the marshal at roughly 25meter spacing, your time will be recorded when you stop on the second line. A competitor who overshoots the Test Finish Stop Astrides will be penalised, under no circumstances should you reverse the car back to the line. The marshal will sign the competitor's Timecard.

All Finish Control will operate this process where crews are required to Stop twice before reaching the marshal.

ASR 24

Please make sure that your car is compliant with all current Motorsport UK Year Book requirements, the scrutineers will be paying particular attention to tyres, handbrakes and interior trim, please make sure that all are compliant with Regulations. Non-compliant will mean No Start. All tyres will be marked – please have spare wheels loose and ready for inspection at Scrutineering.

Please make sure that all tyres are E-marked and we recommend knobbly tyres.

OTHER INFORMATION

- No cheques will be accepted at signing on, cash payments only for any outstanding fees
- All competitors must wear seatbelts/harnesses on all Sections at all times.
- We have been reminded by the Motorsport UK that all incidents which result in an injury need to be reported to the Police and the Stewards in accordance with Section 170 of The Road Traffic Act 1988 and Rule 286 of The Highway Code.
- There is a strict no smoking policy within and around the start and finish venue
- Please ensure that you have written in your competition number on all event documentation
- Evening meal tickets will be handed out in the drivers pack.
- A strict 5mph speed limit exists at the start and finish venue; Please adhere to this
- WC's will be available at the start, rest halt and finish venue
- All tests are on private property with footpath closures and we are not encouraging any spectators to attend.
- **NO IN CAR CAMERAS ARE PERMITTED**

PLEASE NOTE:

PR work before the event has identified some locations where local inhabitants have requested disturbance to be minimised. Competitors **MUST** heed quiet zones along the route, all road sections have been timed generously so there is no reason or excuse not to pay attention to these requirements; any crew not complying with these requirements will be Disqualified. DSO's will be present at these locations.

In the case of an emergency please reference the contacts list in the Road Books and Marshall packs.

We hope you have an enjoyable rally, and we look forward to seeing you all on Sunday the 7th July in Knighton. We wish you a safe journey to and from the event.

Please remember that this is a charity event, not a championship event, raising money in memory of a very special member of Knighton Motor Club who we lost last year through brain cancer. We're here for a good time, not a long time.
